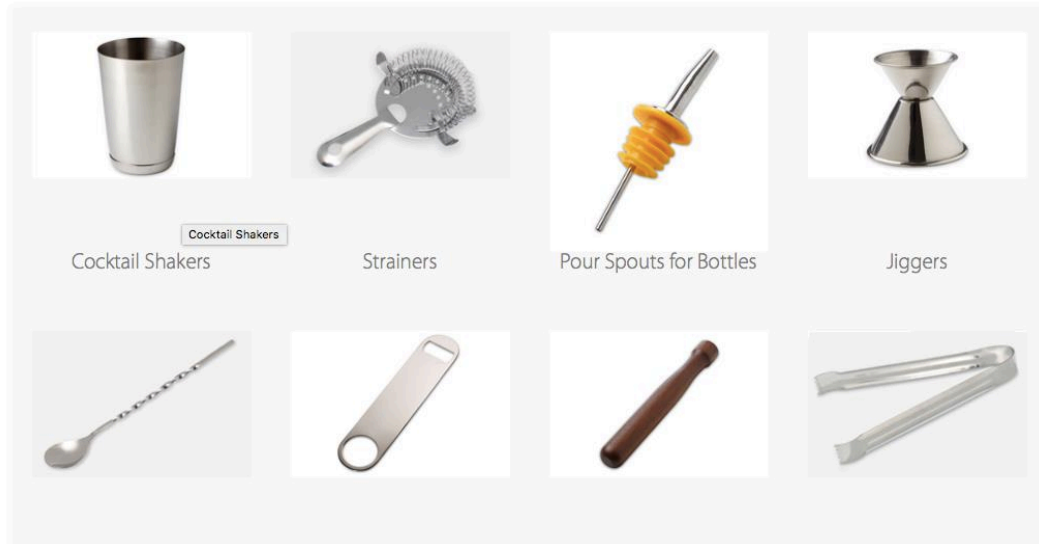

H2: Boston vs. Cobbler: Which **Cocktail Shaker** Should You Choose?

When it comes to cocktail shaking, there are only two shakers that reign supreme: the “Boston” and the “Cobbler”. WidgetCo has compiled a quick guide to choosing the right **cocktail shaker** for your home or business. Here are the pros and cons:

H3: 1. The Cobbler Shaker

The Cobbler is most commonly used by beginner bartenders and cocktail hobbyists who like to make their own concoctions at home. A Cobbler will consist of three parts: a stainless-steel cup, a lid with a strainer and a metal cap to cover it. You simply pour the ingredients into the cup, add the ice, put on the lid and shake. This type of shaker can be shaken with one hand, making it ideal for the multi-tasker. One of the downsides of using a cobbler is that the lid can be finicky and hard to get off. The strainer opening is also smaller than the Boston so the pour speed can be a little slow due to ice getting stuck.

H3: 2. Boston

The Boston is a favorite of professional bartenders due to its quick pour speed and efficiency. The Boston **cocktail shaker** consists of two parts, a metal tumbler and a mixing glass. You simply pour your ingredients into the tumbler, place the mixing glass on top and shake with two hands. This method allows the bartender to mix more than one drink at once which makes it ideal for commercial settings. The only downside is that it’s easy for the mixing glass to become loose especially if the bartender isn’t experienced. The bartender will also have to use a separate [strainer](#) to pour the drink.

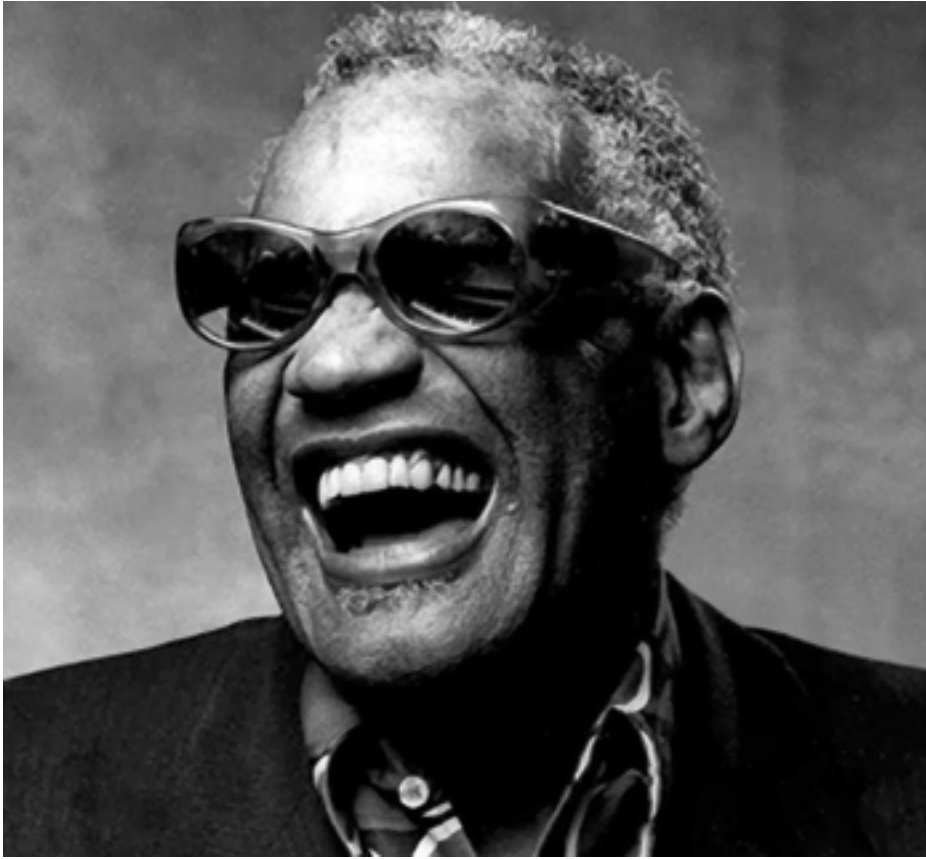
