HAPPIEST SEASIDE TOWN. The title given to Downtown Stuart by *Coastal Living* magazine. This “Old Florida” gem offers Main Street USA appeal alongside the glistening waterfront of the Treasure Coast. Stroll the historic district to explore local shops and dining locales in properties rich with history and heritage.

Enjoy your morning coffee at *Blue Door* with its vibrant entryway and cozy interior and enchanting patio, followed by lunch on the water at *Stuart Boathouse*, oysters and cocktails

at *Riverwalk Café and Oyster Bar*, and dinner at the popular family-owned and operated bistro, *The Gafford*. For a casual evening out, enjoy live music at *Terra Fermata* tiki bar or settle into the white linen dining room of the dockside *Sailor's Return*. Sate your sweet tooth at *Signature Sweets Chocolate and Ice Cream*, where every indulgence is created in-house with locally grown ingredients. Venture just outside of the historic downtown for a healthy juice at *City Beets*, a wine-pairing

dinner at *The Chef's Table*, or a locally-sourced dish at *The District Table*.

Browse local boutiques for clothing and décor, like resort wear from *Monkee's* and *Matilda's*, shop women's apparel and accessories at *April Daze*, peruse the coastal and preppy wares at *O'Sole Mio*, and visit the “purveyors of cool stuff” at *Earth Tones*. From footwear at *Tootsies* to unique home goods and gifts from *Decorator's Finest*, there is much to discover along the streets of downtown.

Known as the “*Sailfish Capital of the World*,” follow the *Sailfish Marker* trail to explore the history of this century-old town with highlights like the *Court House Cultural Center*, *Stuart Feed Store Museum*, and iconic sailfish statue. Be sure to browse the calendar at the historic *Lyric Theater* for live shows and concerts and don't miss the handful of galleries like *Goeffrey C. Smith*, *Rare Earth*, and *Gallery 36* offering photography, paintings, and sculptural art.

Walk above the Atlantic on the winding *Riverwalk* boardwalk for views of the oceanfront,

boats, and estates or hop aboard the *Tiki Taxi* for a cruise at *Tide House Restaurant* or the *Downtown Stuart Dock*. Enjoy live music occurring daily at various venues throughout the area including the *Riverwalk Stage*. Partake in frequent community events like the *Sunday Green Market*, annual arts and crafts festivals, holiday happenings, and *Shopapalooza* sidewalk sales featuring local storefronts.

Travel by car or take advantage of the city docks to arrive by boat and take part in the lively gatherings that make this place so special.

*Wandering this endearing town will leave you feeling relaxed yet invigorated with its slow pace, engaging atmosphere, and eclectic offerings.*

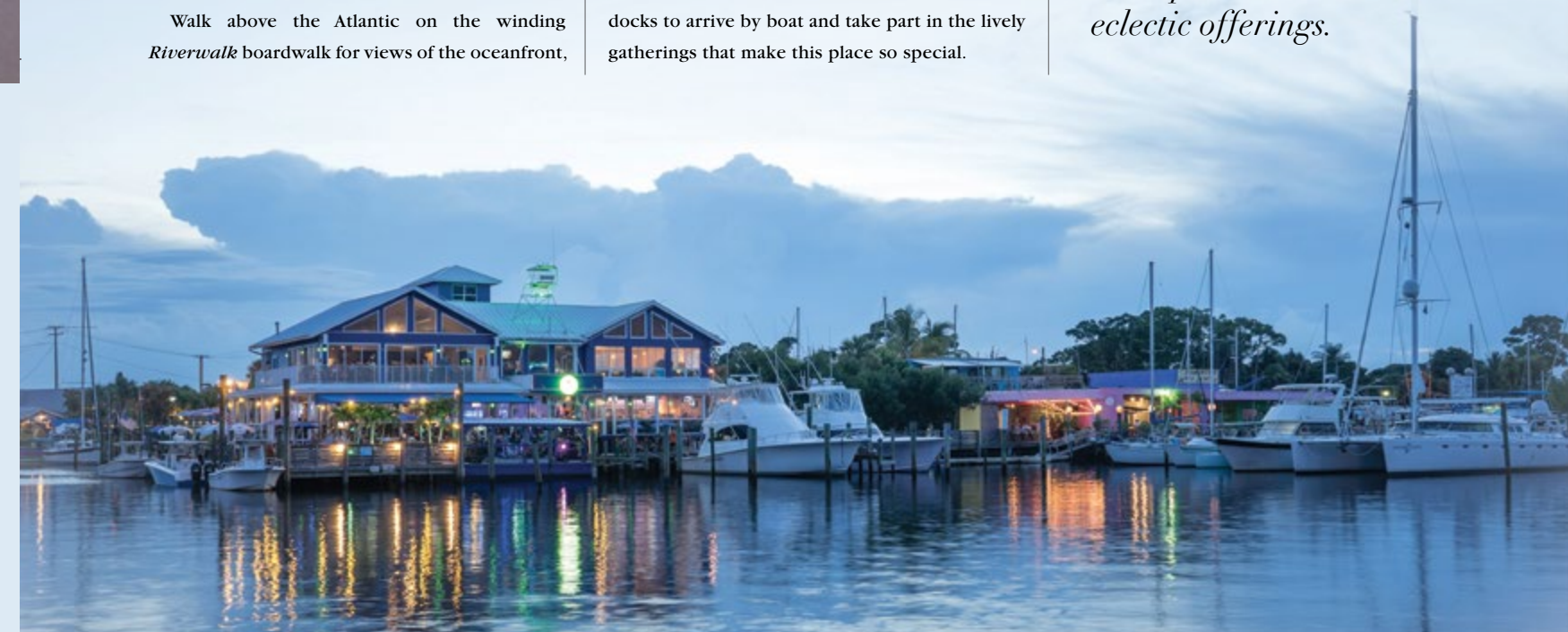
