

Outdoor Adventure Star Misty Wells Explores Clay County for Upcoming Discovery Channel Segment

CLAY COUNTY, FL — Clay County's outdoor adventure scene is getting a well-deserved moment in the national spotlight. Misty Wells, host of the award-winning series *Take it Outside with Misty Wells*, recently visited the area to film a new segment that highlights Clay County as one of Florida's most underrated destinations for outdoor recreation.

Wells, a Florida native and passionate advocate for getting people of all ages involved in the outdoors, brought her signature mix of excitement, exploration, and local storytelling to her Clay County adventure. She spent time on the water with Captain Burke of South Cove Charters and Excursions, where she explored the scenic St. Johns River and reeled in local catches like flounder and red drum (redfish). One highlight of the day included a "hook and cook" experience at local favorite Whitey's Fish Camp, where she enjoyed her freshly caught fish prepared by the kitchen.

Beyond the river, Misty hit the trails and visited historical sites, including military museums that offer a deeper look at the area's legacy. Along the way, she connected with residents—paddlers, business owners, and fellow outdoor enthusiasts—who shared their stories and gave her an insider's view of the community's charm.

"We're excited to welcome Misty Wells and her team to Clay County to experience the natural beauty and adventure that make this region stand out," said Teddy Meyer, Director of Tourism for Clay County. "From the St. Johns River to scenic trails and favorite local spots, Clay County offers the kind of simple, memorable outdoor experiences people often overlook.
